Camp Features

- Certified Athletic Trainer will be in attendance at every wrestling session
- Meals will be served in the Crow's Nest, the university's campus restaurant. Each meal will be buffet style.
- Each camper will have the opportunity to receive 1-on-1 coaching
- Camp t-shirt
- Barn Cat Tough competition
- Current & former UMary Wrestlers and coaches will serve as clinicians and camp counselors

WHAT TO BRING

- Wrestling Gear: Wrestling shoes, headgear (recommended), knee pad (if you need one), singlet (recommended not required), and water bottle
- Several pairs of workout clothes that will get you through all the sessions in one day
 - o I.e., Socks, briefs, shorts/sweatpants, t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc.
 - **NOTE: There are washer and dryers in the residence halls. Bring laundry detergent to wash your clothes at night or in between sessions.
- Shampoo, body wash, clean towels
- For the Resident campers
 - o A TWIN (XL) extra-long mattress, five inches longer than a traditional twin, IS PROVIDED.
 - o Blankets, sheets, pillows are NOT provided.
 - o Bring a sleeping bag OR sheets (for a twin XL mattress) & blanket for a twin size mattress.
 - o Bring a **PILLOW!**
 - o It is recommended to bring a fan to stay cool in the residence hall

The focus of UMary Wrestling Camp is to teach, regardless of one's current skill level, high level technique in a diverse range of wrestling styles to become successful. It will be emphasized for each camper to further their technical capabilities of one's own wrestling style. The camp will feature a mix of technique while emphasizing the importance of learning how to spar through wrestling positions that will encourage one to LEARN specific wrestling position(s), instead of doing a move because "coach" told you to do it. The last wrestling session of each day will be dedicated to live/sparring to allow for implementation and assessment of skills developed through one-on-one coaching. We will also have nightly discussions on a variety of topics to help the campers develop their overall wrestling IQ.

Featured Clinicians



Adam Aho | Entering his 10th season as the University of Mary's Head Wrestling Coach. Since taking over the helm, Aho has coached seven of the program's ten NCAA II All-Americans. He has also led two individuals, Phillip Springsteen & Braydon Huber, to earned 2X NCAA II All-American honors, making them UMary's only multiple time DII All-Americans. In 2018, Aho was named the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year and coached both the 2018 NSIC Wrestler of the Year, Tate Barnhardt, & NSIC Freshman of the Year, Phillip Springsteen. Aho's 2022 season was capped off with qualifying four individuals for the NCAA DII National Tournament, which is the most DII national qualifiers in the program's history. To put an explanation mark on the 2022 season, Reece Barnhardt finished 4th in country as a true freshman, making him the highest DII placer in the program's history, and was named the 2022 NCAA DII Rookie of the Year. Reece is the first in UMary's history to

earn this award. Aho has enhanced fan experience leading to average attendance of 927 during the 2019 season ranking the Marauders in the top 20 compared to all NCAA schools (DI included). He was a four-year starter at North Dakota State University during his collegiate career and was a 3X MN state place winner, finishing his senior season with a State Championship in 2004.



Micheal Elliott is entering his second year at the University of Mary as an Assistant Wrestling Coach. He coached four National qualifiers in the 2022 season and one All-American for the Marauders. Coach Elliott wrestled at Appalachian State University. During his high school career Elliott was the 2014 North Carolina State Champion and a 4X state place winner.
